Dear Cristo Rey Tampa Parents and Guardians,

As we prepare for Spring Break, we remain vigilant in monitoring the status of the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) and its impact on our community. Our entire campus will undergo a deep cleaning that includes removing all items from classrooms and cleaning with commercial-grade disinfectant. Desks, chairs, doors, computers, and floors will all be cleaned to ensure your child's learning environment is as germ-free as possible.

Upon return from Spring Break, we will continue to take steps to prevent the spread of illnesses across our campus by following the recommendations of the Centers for Disease Control (CDC):

- Scheduling regular times throughout the day for students to clean their hands with an alcohol-based hand sanitizer or wash their hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Reminding students about coughing and sneezing etiquette.
- Routinely cleaning all frequently touched surfaces in the school, such as desks, computers, and doorknobs, and providing disposable wipes so that commonly used surfaces can be wiped down before each use

We will continue to ask that students and staff who have symptoms of respiratory illness **STAY HOME AND NOT COME TO SCHOOL** until they are free of fever (100.4° F [37.8° C], signs of a fever, and any other symptoms for at least 24 hours, without the use of fever- or other symptom-altering medicines (e.g., cough suppressants). If you are traveling during Spring Break, please stay vigilant and continue to practice illness control precautions.

At Cristo Rey Tampa HS, we value the health and safety of our students, staff, families, and Corporate Work Study Partners. We will continue to monitor the situation and communicate any changes, if needed, using our school-based communication system.
