Dear Cristo Rey Parents/Guardians:

Based on the directive of the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) to close school for two weeks due to the coronavirus (COVID-19), Cristo Rey Tampa Salesian High School (CRTSHS) on-campus classes will resume on Monday, March 30, barring any further directives issued by the FLDOE.

While we are on Spring Break this week (March 16-20) and our campus is receiving a deep cleaning, we will also remain closed the week of March 23-27 out of necessary precautions. All classes, Corporate Work Study, events, and activities have been canceled or postponed.

During the week of March 23-27, CRTSHS students will receive instruction via online communication through various online platforms. Our administrators and teachers are in the process of planning class lessons and the format students will use on their Chromebooks to receive instruction.

We will post all updates on our website homepage as well as send messages via phone, text, and email. While the safety and well-being of our school community is our priority, we are also committed to keeping you informed.

Please remember during these next two weeks:

- Student instruction will continue the week of March 23-27, and we will notify you of the details later in the week.
- Continue to take precautions to stop the spread of infection. Wash your hands with an alcohol-based hand sanitizer or soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Practice proper coughing and sneezing etiquette and social distancing.
- Travel: Under guidance from the Department of Education and Florida Health Department, anyone who travels out of the country or on a cruise MUST self-isolate for 14 days upon return.

As this situation continues to unfold, we will continue to monitor and post updates. We are in communication with our colleagues at the Diocese of St. Petersburg and Hillsborough County Public Schools to bring you up-to-date information.
