



COVID-19 Decision Tree - STUDENTS

- Symptoms**
- Fever (99°F or higher)
 - Loss of smell or tast
 - Cough
 - Muscle aches
 - Sore throat
 - Shortness of breath
 - Chills
 - New or unusual headache
 - Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea or loss of appetite

STUDENTS/PARENTS WILL

1. Notify administrator(s) and stay home or if at school, student will be isolated and need to be picked up ***within 60 minutes of notification***
2. Contact physician and follow medical care
3. Obtain COVID-19 Test and complete DOSP Contact Tracing Form

ADMINISTRATOR WILL

1. Contact Pastor and President, and notify instructors that the student(s) will be attending virtually,
2. Work with student/ family to complete DOSP Contact Tracing Form

If Student Tests Positive

STUDENTS/PARENTS WILL

1. Notify administrator of result
2. Continue medical care as instructed
3. Return to school only after:
72 hours have passed since recovery (No fever and improvement of respiratory symptoms) AND 14 days have passed since symptoms first appeared
OR
2 negative COVID tests given 24 hours apart (copy of results to administrator)

ADMINISTRATOR WILL

1. Notify Pastor and President
2. Notify teachers and students listed on the Contact Tracing Form.
3. Notify the health department and adhere to the specific guidelines that they will provide.
4. Send general communication to staff and parent community

If Student Tests Negative

STUDENTS/PARENTS WILL

1. Notify Administrator of result (copy of results to administrator)
2. Continue medical care as instructed
3. Return to school after 24 hours have passed since recovery (No fever and general improvement of symptoms)

ADMINISTRATOR WILL

1. Notify Pastor and President

Is Student aware of contact with someone who has been diagnosed with or tested positive for COVID-19?

Yes, there was direct physical and close contact (less than 6 feet) for 15 minutes or more where neither parties were using face masks or coverings.

STUDENTS/PARENTS WILL

1. Notify administrator
2. Keep child home and follow local school distance learning plan
3. Contact child's physician and obtain Covid-19 Test
4. Monitor by checking for fever and symptoms
5. Follow directives for "If Student Tests positive" or "If Student Tests Negative"
6. Return to school only after providing copy of negative test result or after 14 days have passed since initial contact.

ADMINISTRATOR WILL

1. Notify Pastor and President
2. Work with Parents/Student to complete DOSP Contact Tracing Form
3. Follow directives for "If Student Tests positive" or "If Student Tests Negative."

Yes, there was non-close contact (greater than 6 feet) and/or the contact lasted less than 15 minutes and/or face masks or coverings were used by one or both parties.

STUDENTS/PARENTS WILL

1. Student will be requested to stay home for 4-6 days. Parents must monitor their child(ren) by checking for fever and other symptoms.
2. Continue practicing social distancing, face mask wearing, and good hygiene.
3. Follow directives for "YES SYMPTOMS" if symptoms appear.
4. After 4-6 days without symptoms, the student is allowed to return to campus.

ADMINISTRATOR WILL

1. Maintain contact parents for updates.

No, the student is unaware of any contact with someone who is infected or diagnosed with Covid-19

STUDENTS/PARENTS WILL

1. Continue practicing social distancing, face mask wearing, and good hygiene
