CDC SAYS SAFE TO RETURN TO CAMPUS

- 1. The 14 day average number of daily cases is less than 300.
- 2. The positivity rate is 6% or less- right now is higher but projected to fall.
- 3. Vaccinations- most teachers will have completed at least their first vaccination by Spring Break.
- 4. High risk individuals (the elderly or those with medical history that make them vulnerable) also have access to the vaccine.



RETURN TO CAMPUS BY GRADE

- Seniors on March 22nd
- Grades 9 to 11 on April 6th
- Seniors are first because we must make sure they are on track to graduate and they conclude their last day 2 weeks earlier
- There will be NO dual modality teaching on March 22nd for seniors and April 6th for 9 to 11 grades



UNIQUE CIRCUMSTANCES

- IF you have a unique circumstance, you must email Mr. Torano and get explicit permission for your child to continue e-learning.

COVID RELATED ABSENCE

Must have symptoms AND a positive test to have an excused absence
OR

- IF student has had contact with COVID, they must be immediately tested and have a positive result
- Test must happen the SAME day
 - Prolonged absences awaiting testing will be considered unexcused



ABSENCES MUST BE EXCUSED

- 3 unexcused absences= Parent meeting
- 5 unexcused absences = Truancy notice sent to Sherriff's Office
- 8 unexcused absences = dismissal from school
